THE NATIONAL DRIVER EDUCATION CREDENTIAL POINT RECORDING FORM

The National Credential will expire three years after initial issuance. To maintain this credential, points must be accrued over the three-year time frame. During this time frame, a teacher must accumulate a minimum of **30 points** to continue his/her national credential. Points may be earned in the following ways:

- 1. Membership in ADTSEA or other national and/or state professional traffic safety associations 2 points per year.
- 2. Registration and participation in state and national professional organization conferences 2 points per conference.
- 3. Successful completion of professional development workshops or courses (30 contact hours or 3 credits minimum) 3 points per course/workshop.
- Teaching driver education students 1 point per 30 hours of instruction completed in any phase (classroom, laboratory or on-street instruction). Must teach at least a total of 30 hours in one or more phases in the one year period to maintain credential.
- 5. Teaching state or nationally approved driver improvement courses 1 point per 30 hours of instruction.
- 6. Publication of articles in professional journals 2 points per article authored or co-authored.
- 7. Elected officer in state or national, professional traffic safety organization 1 point per year.
- 8. Other professional development activities as approved on an individual basis by the ADTSEA office 1 point per approval.
